## 48 Consideration of Planning Applications

- 48.1 T/22/93619 Orchard Gardens Care Home 1 no. Monterey Pine (0321) Reduce upper crown to reduce loading on failure point. Reduce by 1m and selective thin secondary branches.
- 1 no. Monterey Pine (0340) Reduce 1x long overextended slender limb in south-west crown that overhangs the woodland path. Reduce by approx. 4m to suitable secondary growth point. Maintain balanced crown outline;
- 1 no. Monterey Pine (0401) Fell and replant;
- $1\ \mathrm{no}$ . Corsican Pine (0483) Reduce outer secondary branches from northern stem by  $2\mathrm{m}$  to suitable growth points;
- 1 no. Holly (0489)- Crown reduce by 3-4m to create framework and install a prop to support the stem;
- 2 no. Limes (0298, 0300) Cut basal epicormics;
- 2 no. Atlas Cedar (0073, 0074)- Fell and replant;
- 1 no, Wellingtonia (0087)- Fell and replant;
- 1 no. Beech (0112)- Reduce crown overhanging the road by 3m in height and spread;
- 1 no. False Acacia (0098)- Fell;
- 1 no. Lime (0105) Cut basal epicormics and deadwood;
- 1 no. Sycamore (0038)- Fell and replant;
- 1 no. Oak (0231) Reduce unstable deadwood, reducing crown by 5-6m to create high habitat tree;

1 no. Oak (0232) - Remove split branch back to suitable growth point;

1 no. Sweet Chestnut (0540)- Reduce upper dead crown, removing deadwood down to stable height, retain for habitat;

1 no. Copper Beech (0195)- Reduce south limb by 2m to suitable growth point. Reduce outer crown of eastern primary limb by 2m to reduce end weight and load on union;

1 no. Copper Beech (00952)- Remove hanging branch over path and any unstable deadwood;

1 no. Fir (1018) – Fell;

1 no. Cypress (1025)- Remove hung up stem;

1 no. Western Red Cedar (1032) - Fell -

The Committee agreed to object to the felling of any trees pending an inspection by the Borough Council Tree Officer and the production of a long-term plan to maintain the replacement trees.
